### **IRYMPLE BOWLS CLUB READY FOR RENOS**

The Irymple Bowls Club will see an entire kitchen upgrade thanks to their success under the Federal Governments Stronger Communities programme. The club will receive a \$18,181 grant to carry the extensive renovations needed to get their kitchen up to standard.

Federal Member for Mallee Andrew Broad says as it stands the clubs kitchen facilities don't meet Australia food safety standards and it's making it tough on memberships and social participation.

"This \$18,181 is going to make a world of difference to the club, the kitchen upgrade will ensure they have the facilities to keep up with club activities and engage more members," he said.

With a strong membership made up a lot for retirees the upgraded kitchen facilities will make it a lot easier for club members to make their way around the new space and use the kitchen facilities for social functions.

Proposed fixed works will include all new concealed cabinetry, a new ceiling, new floor, new door, new fixed island bench with concealed waste/recycle station, a new pantry, new exhaust/ventilation system, relocation of existing stove, new double sink and tap-ware, as well as a new auto sensor hand-washing station.
