SCHOLARSHIPS FOR OUR REGIONAL STUDENTS

Federal Member for Mallee, Andrew Broad has encouraged students across the Wimmera Mallee and Goldfields regions to apply for a Government-funded scholarship to study a science, engineering or mathematics (STEM) course.

Mr Broad said applications are now open for the \$24 million Rural and Regional Enterprise Scholarships program.

“Students across the district will be able to apply for scholarships of up to \$18,000 to help with the costs of studying either a science, engineering or maths course at university or a vocational education and training institution,” Mr Broad said.

“STEM education is full of possibilities and increasingly we are seeing less and less of our students take this pathway.”

“I want to encourage any student who is interested in STEM to apply for the program, we also have new guidelines that will help out those drought-affected students apply.”

Approximately 1200 rural, regional and remote students will receive support through the program.

Applications will close on Friday 14 December.
