\$28,700 TO LOCAL COMMUNITY PROJECTS

The Federal Government's Building Better Regions Fund Community Investment Stream has delivered \$28,700 to the Electorate of Mallee for two projects in Dimboola and the Northern Grampians.

Federal Member for Mallee notified the Hindmarsh Shire Council and the Northern Grampians Shire Council of their success this week and said the community-based projects were a positive investment in the region.

"This is a great outcome for these local communities, with two projects receiving a share of \$28,700."

"The Hindmarsh Shire Council will receive \$10,000 for their Dimboola Human Powered Vehicle Event. This is an innovative and exciting event for everyone in the community to attend."

"The Northern Grampians Shire Council will receive \$18,700 for their project, Recreation Futures in Northern Grampians," Mr Broad said.

The projects will bring great benefit to the regional towns of Dimboola, Stawell and St Arnaud and their surrounding communities.

"The Community Investment stream of the Building Better Regions Fund is part of our plan to make sure regional Australia and our local communities are supported, and I am hopeful we will have even more announcements when the Infrastructure Stream is announced in the coming weeks."
