REDUCING SOCIAL ISOLATION ACROSS THE REGION

Federal Member for Mallee, Andrew Broad has congratulated two local community groups who have been successful under the Federal Governments *Veteran & Community Grants Program*.

The Mildura Totally Permanently incapacitated and Extreme Disabled Adjustment (TPI EDA) Social Club and Princes Court Homes in Mildura will both receive funding to help reduce social isolation for those living in the community.

“Princes Court Homes will receive a grant of \$50,000 to help them purchase a bus for those living residentially to get out and about , and Mildura TPI EDA Social Club will see \$8,415 to go towards taking groups on a number of trips out in the community,” Mr Broad said.

“Social isolation and loneliness is a real problem, particularly for our aging population and we want to see them out and interacting with one another and the community as much as possible.”

“These are two very deserving local organisations doing fantastic work across Mildura and as a government we are backing them to help support our veteran community.”
